The European Documentation Centers (EDC)

are set up by the European Commission at the Universities and Research centers of all member Countries and some third Countries;
are activated through a convention that regulates the rights and duties of each party;
have printed and electronic documentation produced by the Community institutions and make it accessible to the academic world and to the general public;
are part of the information network Europe Direct coordinated by the European Commission's Directorate-General for Communication.

Purposes

to help the host structure to promote and to consolidate teaching and research in the field of European integration;
to make accessible to the public, including non-university, documentation on the Union and its policies;
to establish contacts with other EDCs and information networks in order to paint the debate on the European Union.

Objectives and Services

to offer students, academic scholars and citizens an integrated information and documentation service on the EU's activities;
to develop, in synergy with other Commission networks, initiatives to foster greater knowledge of Union policies;
to become within the Universities and Research Centers a key point of information on the institutions and policies of the Union.

Primary audience

university students
university professors
citizens

The Italian Network of European Documentation Centers

consists of 51 centers set up at universities and research centers;
is coordinated by the European Commission Representation in Italy;
is the most widespread and consolidated in the national network of public community source;
provides, in accordance with internal rules, the presence of a national coordinator, a deputy coordinator and a coordination group.

Network Activities

Activities and services at the local level

access to official documents of the European institutions;
bibliographic information and research on EU issues;
orientation for on-line research of Community material;
training for the use of European databases;
realization of master, training courses and seminars on community issues;
publications for the academic world on European integration.

National Site

created in 2002 and hosted on a server at the University of Sassari;
is systematically updated by an editorial team with the collaboration of all EDCs.

Aims

 - on the policies of the EU;
 - on the activities of the Italian EDC network;
 - on the official documentation of the Union;
 - on calls for EU funding;
 - on events, master classes, training courses relevant to the European themes offered by Universities and National Research Centers;

 - Internet databases and resources on the Union and its policies.
